<sup>3</sup> Internal/external transfer students who have already taken two approved general education science classes are exempt from CSC 112 or GEO 104.

<sup>5</sup> SPK 208 or SPK 230 recommended

<sup>6</sup> A minimum GPA of 2.50 is required to register for 300- or 400-level business classes.

<sup>7</sup> This course fulfills the Capstone requirement.
