CHO 511. Masterworks Chorus. 1 Credit.

A large mixed chorus presenting oratorios, masses, and advanced-level choral literature.

CHO 541. Applied Choral Conducting I. 3 Credits.

Advanced individualized instruction in choral conducting, culminating in a full master's recital.

Typically offered in Fall & Spring.

CHO 542. Applied Choral Conducting II. 3 Credits.

Advanced individualized instruction in choral conducting, culminating in a full master's recital.

Typically offered in Fall & Spring.

CHO 543. Applied Choral Conducting III. 3 Credits.

Advanced individualized instruction in choral conducting, culminating in a full master's recital.

Admission by audition.

CHO 611. Chamber Choir. 1 Credit.

A consort of 15-25 singers specializing in the performance of sacred and secular vocal music of the Renaissance and early Baroque periods. By audition.

CHO 612. Concert Choir. 1 Credit.

A mixed chorus of 35-45 singers performing sacred and secular choral literature of all periods and styles. By audition.

Master's in Choral Conducting degree recital.
