GRE 201 Prerequisite: Successful completion of GRE 102 with minimum grade of D-.

GRE 202. Intermediate Greek II. 3 Credits.

Homeric prosody and grammar. Reading of selected portions of the Homeric Poems. GRE 202 Prerequisite: Successful completion of GRE 201 with minimum grade of D-.

GRE 301. Greek Reading I: Homer. 3 Credits.

Readings in prose and verse. Authors usually selected by genre. This course may be taken again for credit.

GRE 301 Prerequisite: Successful completion of GRE 202 with minimum grade of D-.

GRE 302. Greek Reading II: Greek Historians. 3 Credits.

Continuation of readings in prose and verse. Authors usually selected by genre. This course may be taken again for credit.
