The courses chosen for the focused inquiry should assist the student in understanding and addressing the thematic concern, which was chosen and investigated within the Pre-Candidacy Phase, so that the courses help the student in fleshing out the problem and identifying potential solutions. The focused inquiry sequence does not need to be selected from a single content area, but may straddle many different areas; possibly from across the university.
