- <sup>3</sup> Up to two elective courses may be taken outside of the Department of Psychology. Courses restricted to clinical psychology majors cannot be taken as electives.
- <sup>4</sup> Students may, with permission, enroll for the thesis (PSY 610) for up to six credit hours. Students electing the thesis option will be expected to complete at least 42 credit hours.
