- ¹ Restrictive Major Requirement (RMR): To remain in the major or to transfer into the major, students must complete the following prerequisite courses with a GPA of at least a 3.0 and a minimum grade of "C" or better: CSD 101, CSD 106, WRT 1XX, MAT 103 or above, CSD 203, CSD 207, ENG 230/LIN 230, and WRT 2XX.
- 2 Students must take (1) BIO and (2) CHE or PHY as the Science Courses to meet the standard of the American Speech-Language Hearing Association.
- Students may not use more than a total of three repeats across the CSD courses to satisfy the Restrictive Major Requirement (CSD 101, CSD 106, CSD 203, and CSD 207).

Accelerated B.A. in Communication Sciences and Disorders to M.A. in Speech-Language Pathology Program

To be considered for the accelerated program, students must have attained (completed) 72 credits and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.7 and a minimum major GPA of 3.7. Also, students must submit at least two references from the CSD faculty. Students in the accelerated program can substitute up to 12 credits of graduate coursework for electives that satisfy the B.A. program requirements. B.A. degree is conferred at the end of fall semester in Year 4.

The following M.A. courses will be the accelerated students' elective courses. The 12 credits in the fall semester of Year 4 are counted as the elective requirements for the B.A. and required courses for the M.A.
